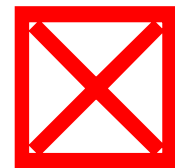


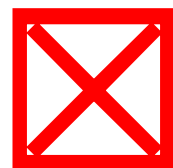

SCHOLARSHIP GRANT APPLICATION

Each year the San Diego and Imperial Counties American Public Works Chapter awards up to four scholarship grants to students pursuing civil engineering, other public works/construction related or other closely related technical STEM field degrees. For this year, the grants are \$500 each. **Deadline for submittal is July 26, 2019***.

ELIGIBILITY:

- Students must be pursuing a degree in a public works related field, such as civil engineering, surveying, construction management, or other closely related technical fields associated with STEM.
- Students must be taking at least 12-units of coursework in 2019/2020.
- Students must have a permanent address within the Chapter region (San Diego and Imperial Counties).
- Each selected grantee must attend a Chapter General Lunch Meeting to be held in July or August to receive the award, a certificate describing the award, and to be recognized by the local professional community that funds the grants.
- Applications that are not completely filled out may be disqualified.
