Thank you for your interest in the American Public Works Association San Diego and Imperial Counties Chapter Summer Internship Program. This Program is intended to promote Public Works Internships. The goal of program is to support proper selection, placement and development of students or recent graduates from local universities and colleges. This service was developed to encourage internships in Public Works by providing employers with: APWA recruitment efforts, a stipend to offset costs of employment, an applicant screening process, and recognition amongst peers for efforts to improve the prospects of employment for our local graduating students. In the past, as many as 18 interns have been placed in a single summer.
